1. Black Forest Ham with Swiss cheese, home-made sweet hot mustard, Roma tomatoes, and Romaine lettuce
2. Oven Roasted Turkey Breast with provolone cheese, slow roasted red peppers and Romaine lettuce
3. Pepper Crusted Roast Beef with sharp cheddar, horseradish sauce, Romaine lettuce, tomato and red onion.
4. Roasted Vegetable Antipasti with goat cheese, black olive tapenade, roasted red peppers, artichoke hearts and fresh herbs with balsamic vinaigrette.
