couscous around 10 and the dancing started around 11. At 2, we couldn't handle it any more and left to go to bed before the cake had been cut. When we

talked to others later, they said that the party lasted until about 5 or 6.

This month, we also had another cake decorating team come to work with our group at La Courneuve. The ladies had such a fun time, especially since all of the team members were returning and the women were already familiar with them. My favorite part was on Wednesday afternoon with the girls that come for English. At the beginning of the class, we shared a story about

Jesus and the women who washed his feet with her tears. The girls listened attentively and then went about decorating their cookies. Afterwards, they were intrigued by the flannelgraph figures and went to play with them, practicing retelling the story.

This month had an extra special blessing with the birthday and baptism of David (on the same day!). David got to share what God has been doing in his life and then "died to himself to live in Christ" in our church's first baptism by immersion in a pool he built himself.
